

## VISA EVIDENCE GUIDANCE – NEW APPLICANTS

**ALL documents sent MUST be original copies.**

**If your documents are not in English, you must provide a fully certified translation by a professional authorised translator.**

### **MONEY**

College fees paid or to be paid

- CAS to prove payments received so far
- Bank statement to prove ability to pay – must show that this money has been held for at least 28 days
- The documents to prove your availability of your money must be dated no more than one month before you submit your application

Maintenance (Accommodation)

- Proof of ability to pay 5400 GBP – must show that this money has been held for at least 28 days
- The documents to prove your availability of your money must be dated no more than one month before you submit the application

### **ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT**

The CAS Statement lists the evidence you will need to provide.

### **OTHER**

- Parental Consent letter for students under the age of 18
  - This letter is to agree that their child, the student, can travel and live independently. (This means independently of them, the parents, and not alone in the UK).
- Two Photographs
- Completed Application form with CAS number included
- The payment

**ALL original documents must be brought with you to the UK. Keep them safe and in your hand luggage. You may be asked to produce this evidence at the UK Airport's passport control.**
